

North Shropshire Canvass Briefing

This is a brief guide intended to help you answer any questions residents may raise on the doorstep. Please read it before your canvassing session. You do not need to memorise it and most of the time you will not need to use it.

Remember: if you don't know, that's ok! If someone asks you a question and you don't know the answer, just say that you don't know but will pass on their question to Helen. Then complete a casework form to allow us to contact the resident about their question.

Polling day is on Thursday 16 December.

What is the choice in this election?

People face a clear choice in this election - continue to be taken for granted by the Conservatives or get a Liberal Democrat MP who will listen and be a strong voice for local people.

Why only the Liberal Democrats can beat the Conservatives here:

- We finished second across the constituency in May's local elections
 - Twice as many votes as labour and green
 - Labour came 4th in the locals, behind the greens
- We are the second largest party in the Shropshire Council
- In May, the party beat the Conservative Leader of Shropshire Council, came within a knife-edge of a host of council seats and were the only party to increase their vote share

The NHS in North Shropshire is underfunded and is leaving people in pain and in danger. Waiting times for appointments and for ambulances are terrible and everyone seems to have a horror story about access to the NHS.
