I would like to give huge thanks to the AROS, Returning Officers and MI Voice administrators who enabled all the selections to happen, to local party chairs, organisers and campaigners, to agents who looked after all the legalities whilst the candidates campaigned.

I am extremely grateful for the support given me by regional staff, the candidate's committee and the executive and especially to Catherine.

Finally, candidates throughout the region did a great job working so hard building up and motivating teams and supporting colleagues in target seats. The results are testament to their hard work and dedication.
